

Frequently Asked Questions

My parents are members of the credit union. Do I qualify for the scholarship?

No. You must have your own account at a credit union based in North or South Carolina to qualify.

What are the scholarship amounts?

The Carolinas Credit Union Foundation awards \$1,000 scholarships (both needs-based and academic) and \$500 scholarships for technical and community colleges. If your credit union has its own scholarship program, please review its award amounts.

I am in graduate school. Do I qualify for a scholarship?

Yes. The Carolinas Credit Union Foundation provides academic and needs-based scholarships for all levels of higher education. If your credit union has its own scholarship program, please review its scholarship criteria.

My credit union does not have a fund at the Carolinas Credit Union Foundation, can I still apply? Yes! Members from credit unions based in North or South Carolina are eligible to apply.

Can I receive a scholarship from the Carolinas Credit Union Foundation AND my credit union?

No. Applicants who receive a scholarship award from a credit union cannot receive a scholarship from the Carolinas Credit Union Foundation. An applicant that does not receive a scholarship award from a credit union is automatically entered in the Carolinas Credit Union Foundation's scholarship pool. The Carolinas Credit Union Foundation winners are selected after merging the non-winners and scholarship applicants from credit unions that do not have a fund with the Foundation.

An applicant can, however, receive a scholarship award from more than one credit union scholarship fund.
